New Business

Nutrition Nook – Lei inquired if parents should shop for things for Nutrition Nook or should teachers/staff, and is any PC store okay?

-Mr. Shaw's response is that food purchasing will be left to parents

-Mr. Shaw needs a list of things to purchase with \$3500 beyond food (as mentioned above in Wish List)

Fundraising

Lei inquired whether we can plan fundraisers for the new school year?

Mr. Shaw confirmed that yes, can do this and also plan for hot lunch

-Need a plan for fundraising with COVID-19 likely still around in the fall and Arizona thinks that students will be more engaged in fundraising efforts if they are involved in brainstorming fundraising ideas that appeal to them

-Angele mentioned that Brookwood school did a read-a-thon this year and raised \$16,000 with only 100 kids participating

-Arizona said a read-a-thon was proposed at Woodhaven a few years ago and reading was not supported as well at the middle school level as it was at elementary school

Treasurer Report

Arizona reported that the cost of insurance has gone up - it was \$482.48 and is now \$595.13 A comprehensive rider has been added to prevent against monetary fraud.

We have the funds to pay it in the budget.

Arizona moved to approve payment of the insurance, and it was approved by the parent association

New Health and Wellness program for \$400 total – Arizona can use \$1000 in budget for den day activities to pay for health and wellness program prizes; den days did not occur this year due to COVID-19 restrictions. Prizes will be given for health and wellness activities that students complete at recess or lunch
