Report Cards

Your child's report card is now available on Powerschool. You will notice that the comments on the report card are generally quite brief. This is intentional as the comments are actually attached to the assignments that your child's teachers have put into Powerschool. This is where you will find individual assignment marks, missing assignments and comments about how your child is doing in different areas of the curriculum in each subject area. We will be hosting our second round of Parent/Teacher Interviews in March, please plan to attend.

Attendance

This month we will again be reaching out to families of students with declining or low attendance to see how we might assist in improving student attendance. We know, and research supports that when attendance dips below 85%, graduation rate falls below 50%. When we calculate attendance, we remove the days that the buses don't run, so that does not negatively impact a students attendance rate. Please do not hesitate to reach out if you need support with helping get your child to school.

Crosswalk Safety

Our students' safety is our top priority. Please ensure you slow down in the school zone, and use extra precaution at crossing locations. Please also remind your children to ensure it is safe to cross before stepping onto the road. Pedestrians also need to remember to take the road conditions into account to ensure a vehicle will be able to stop for them.
