#### Trustee Report- Eric Cameron

- School tour at Woodhaven
- April report sent a letter to the Minister of Education, Discipline action for Professional Staff. Problem with guidelines and not meeting timelines.
- Edwin Parr Outstanding First Year Teacher Isabella Reynolds at Graminia nominated
- Advocating for SGCHS build. Did not make the list for funding this year. Roadblock
  with funding is in part with Horizon Stage. Half is owned by COSG and half owned by
  PSD. 25% of the land is owned by City and 25% by PSD. Government is asking to
  resolve this before funding will be provided. Negotiations are ongoing with COSG,
  PSD, and the Federal Government to reach resolution.
- Schools have started to participate in International trips. Disneyland, Spain, Portugal, Germany.
- SPC is currently being demolished. Two portables were salvaged and sent to Copperhaven. Land that SPC was on now belongs to the Town of Stony Plain. Stony Plain completed a landtrade once complete.
- Hired 42 Substitute Teachers, 50 Casual EA's. Many changes to administrative appointments.
- Alberta Education has asked to pilot a new K-6 Social Studies curriculum. Schools will be decided at the school level and not directed by the division.
- June 7, 2024 Try Me Triathlon
- Quarterly Financial fiscal year \$2.1 Million surplus. \$1.5 million has been earmarked for Tomahawk School renovations so there are no further delays to renovation completion.
